A few years ago, I rushed my beloved dog to an emergency animal hospital in Tucson. And although I lost her that night and my heart was shattered, I remember one thing, the very kind and loving veterinarian that was with us when she crossed over that rainbow bridge.

So, we fast forward a few years later, when my other dog was severely injured in a horrible dog attack, I was given a phone number to an emergency veterinarian who was working from her small mobile clinic at a ranch in Florence. Imagine my surprise to find the same veterinarian who had helped me years before. My panic and fear were greatly eased. This veterinarian worked on him performing emergency surgery for hours, when most veterinarians would have recommended euthanizing him and this amazing woman saved his life. Who was this angel? When we got word that Dr. King would start coming to the old veterinary clinic in Kearny, we were elated. The

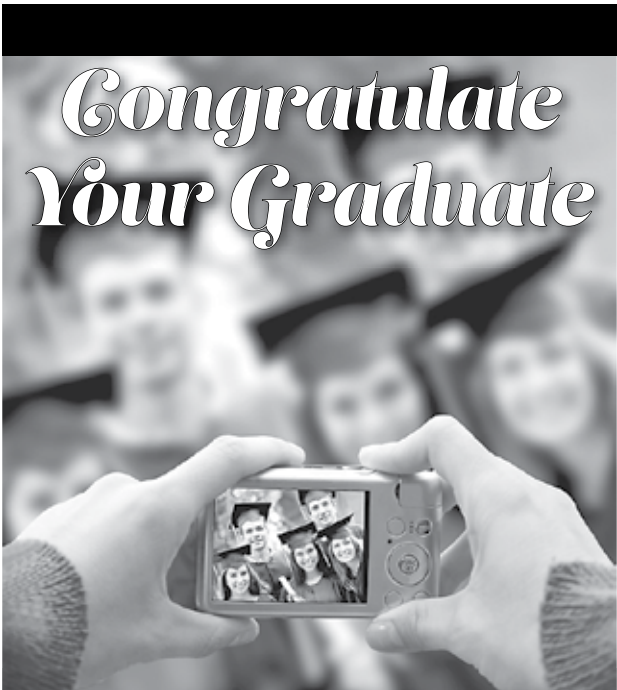

Public Hearing Regarding Use of CDBG Funds

The Town is expected to receive approximately \$253,821 in FY25 federal CDBG funds from the Arizona Department of Housing Regional Account (RA). CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need. A public hearing will be held at 6:00 PM on May 27, 2025, at the Kearny Town Hall Council Chambers; 374 Alden RD, Kearny, AZ 85137 to gather citizen input on the use of the CDBG funds. Examples of possible uses include the following:

- 1) Public infrastructure (e.g., water, wastewater, street improvements);
- 2) Community facilities (e.g., parks, health clinics, libraries, senior or youth centers);
- 3) Housing (e.g., owner-occupied or multi-family rehab, utility connections on private property, new housing constructed by a non-profit);
- 4) Public services (e.g., paying the salary of an additional staff person to expand a Head Start program, purchasing a van to transport persons with disabilities, equipment and rent to start a new job training program).

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Oracle, other communities take action on Wildfire Community Preparedness Day

On Saturday, May 3, residents of Oracle and other communities across Arizona collaborated for Wildfire Community Preparedness Day, a nationwide campaign that encourages residents and organizations to take action to reduce the risk of wildfires.

Held annually on the first Saturday of May, the National Fire Prevention Association's (NFPA) Wildfire Community Preparedness Day empowers residents through grassroots prevention efforts, including community-centric, collaborative projects and outreach events. With fire season year-round in Arizona, this day plays a vital role in boosting community resilience and preparedness.

Wildfire Community Preparedness Day aligns with the NFPA's nationally recognized Firewise USA program which also promotes resident collaboration to create defensible space around homes as part of overall community risk reduction efforts. Some communities like Oracle hosted a preparedness day to help reduce the fire threat to their community. Oracle has been Firewise USA recognized for 20 years and continues to lead by example by opening up their brush pit for the day to residents for

a reduced charge. This initiative allows homeowners a safe way to dispose of yard vegetation, including brush, branches, and leaves – encouraging the creation of defensible space around properties.

“This kind of local action is exactly what Preparedness Day is all about,” said Tina Acosta with the Oracle Fire District. “When neighbors work together, we not only reduce the risk of wildfire but also strengthen our sense of community and shared responsibility.”

There were 70 loads of brush, leaves, tree trimmings and more that were received at the “Brush Dump” on Saturday. It should be noted large tree trunks, building materials and green cacti is never accepted at that site and the resident must reside in the Oracle Fire District Region. Along with several members of the Oracle Firewise Board, Wildland Fire crews from the Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management and the Coronado National Forest assisted in making the day a success.

Other community events supporting Wildfire Community Preparedness Day included, a Firewise Day at Mortimer Farms in Dewey and a fuel removal day for

residents of Colina del Norte in Phoenix. The Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management (DFFM) also hosted a Home Ignition Zone class in Payson for people interested in learning more about the Firewise USA program and home hardening methods.

DFFM takes the lead for the Firewise USA program as the state's liaison for the NFPA. Currently, Arizona has 185 recognized Firewise USA communities. So far this year, DFFM's Prevention Division has onboarded 13 new communities into the program, including the first site in Fountain Hills, with more areas working toward the

Taking time out of her busy life to come to our community to hold Rex Veterinary Clinic at least twice a month is a true blessing. If you have ever been to her clinic, you know how great a commodity she truly is. It is always packed full of locals and their pets.

“Dr. King is the most wonderful human being and vet. When we had to put our dog down, she came to us, she cried with us, and she even mailed us a sympathy card. She has so much empathy for her patients and their families. You won’t get that anywhere else. Thank you, Dr. King for going above and beyond. We are blessed to have you in our community,” said Roxanna Fuerstenberg of Kearny.

I completely agree. In January, I also had to take my ill dog, Sadie, to Dr. King. She had been battling a terminal illness, and her time was quickly coming to an end. So, when I asked her for a photo at the end of the day, showing her true modesty, she stated, “Readers don’t care about me, they would rather see a cute doggy.” We agreed on a photo of Whiskey, a dog she had just squeezed in before closing in to treat for an ear infection, once again, showing that she does this job selflessly, always putting the animals first. She also wanted to include photos of her favorite client, “a really cute baby burro” as she calls him.
